

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
 AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE

NO. 1000

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the County of Solano to encourage the preservation of land for agricultural and open space uses in accordance with principles set forth in the California Land Conservation Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, Application No. 1109 has been made by owners of certain real property in Solano County more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and "B" attached hereto, requesting that said real property of 27.351 acres be placed within an Agricultural Preserve; and

WHEREAS, after public hearings duly held by the Solano County Planning Commission and this Board of Supervisors, it is hereby determined that the establishment of the said proposed Agricultural Preserve is:

1. In the public interest.
2. Consistent with the General Plan.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED that all real property in Solano County, described in Exhibit "A", the property deed description and Exhibit "B", the Assessor's Plat attached hereto, be and hereby is established as an Agricultural Preserve.

I, NEIL CRAWFORD, County Clerk of Solano County, State of California, and ex officio Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of said County, do hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was regularly introduced, passed and adopted by said Board at a regular meeting thereof held on January 13, 1976.
